(tips and stories from a selection of those who saved the most)


- Sheila + Trent removed a large area of grass, saving more than 100,000 gallons of water.

- Colleen + Greg replaced their indoor plumbing, removed water-sucking plants from their yard, and **reprogrammed their irrigation system** to save more than 125,000 gallons.
- Genevieve, Lily and Rumi **removed grass** and built **water-conserving plant beds** in their garden.
